NATIONAL

- Members of the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) have withdrawn ₹39,403 crore between March 25 and August 31, the Labour Ministry informed the Lok Sabha .
- The youth section will also be added to the link of suggestions for the Master Plan-2041 for future Delhi. Under this, the Youth Meetings will be organized by the Delhi Development Authority (DDA) to know the views of the youth. In this, the youth will be able to give their suggestions to the authority.
- With the construction of Orbital Rail Corridor, not only Haryana will also gain momentum. This will not only reduce traffic pressure at Delhi's busiest railway stations, but it will also get rid of the problem of trains coming out to Delhi.
- The Central Government on Tuesday approved the laying of the Orbital Rail Corridor along with the Kundli-Manesar-Palwal (KMP) Expressway. The state government sent its DPR to the center. This project will also reduce the cost of transport by connecting the industrial areas of Haryana with a dedicated freight corridor, saving time.
- More than two thousand patients of corona are being found in the state. The total number of infected people has reached 99841 with 2487 new patients received on Tuesday. In this way, the figure will cross one lakh on Wednesday. 25 people died in a day.

- Minister of State for Finance Anurag Thakur told the Lok Sabha on Monday that FDI (foreign direct investment) inflow from China has decreased from \$350.22 million in 2017-18 to \$163.77 million in 2019-20.

INTERNATIONAL

- The World Trade Organization has said that the US violated global trade rules when it imposed additional tariffs on Chinese goods in 2018.
- China's yuan climbed to its highest in 16 months against the US dollar on Tuesday after data suggested a broader recovery from the coronavirus crisis.
- The coronavirus death toll in the UK has risen to 41,664 after 27 new deaths were reported. Further, the total number of confirmed coronavirus cases in the UK surged to 3,74,228 after 3,105 new cases were reported.
- Rome's Fiumicino Airport has become the first airport in the world to earn the 'COVID-19 5-Star Airport Rating' by Skytrax, an international air transport rating agency.
- A 47-year-old Indian man who stayed in the UAE without any documents for 13 years returned home after the UAE waived more than ₹1 crore in overstay fine.
- While attending a briefing on California wildfires, US President Donald Trump claimed that the climate "will start getting cooler" after officials said they want to recognise what climate change means for forests.
- An immigration detention centre in US' Georgia performed hysterectomies (a surgery in which part or all of the uterus is removed) on women, refused to test detainees for COVID-19 and shredded medical records, Dawn Wooten, a nurse alleged.
- An advertisement from US President Donald Trump's re-election campaign used a stock photo of Russian MiG-29 jets and an AK-74 assault rifle, the Politico magazine quoted experts as saying.
- Some volunteers have quit Johnson & Johnson's coronavirus vaccine trial in Spain after a participant in AstraZeneca's vaccine trial developed severe neurological symptoms, the Spanish programme's lead investigator Alberto Borobia said.
- China imposed a lockdown on Ruili city after local authorities reported two imported cases of coronavirus from neighbouring Myanmar, the state media reported
- US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo on Tuesday said that there are "fewer than 200 al-Qaeda militants left in Afghanistan today".
