- India has reported 10,584 new COVID-19 cases and 78 fatalities in the last 24 hours, as per the Union Health Ministry. With this, the total cases rose to 1,10,16,434, while the death toll reached 1,56,463.
- The petrol and diesel prices in the national capital hit a record high after the price of petrol was increased by 25 paise and diesel price was increased by 35 paise.
- At least six people were killed and one injured when the gelatin sticks they were trying to dispose of exploded accidentally at a stone quarry site in a village in Karnataka's Chikkaballapur in the wee hours.
- Police has booked former MP Dhananjay Mahadik and two others for alleged violation of COVID-19 norms at the marriage function of his son in Pune on February 21.
- Delhi Police said it has arrested city resident Jaspreet Singh, who was seen atop one of Red Fort's minarets amid violence on January 26 this year.
- Delhi government announced that it will launch the Deshbhakti Curriculum in its government schools in the 2021-2022 academic session.
- There are more than 7,000 coronavirus mutations in India of which some could pose a serious risk, said Rakesh Mishra, Director of the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research - Centre for Cellular and Molecular Biology.
- Four people, including three children, were killed and 12 others injured after the tractor-trolley in which they were travelling was hit by a pick-up van in UP's Kanpur.
- Advocate Akhil Sibal, who is representing climate activist Disha Ravi, said he's fighting the case before Delhi High Court on a "pro bono basis" and isn't charging any fees.
- Shiv Sena leader and former Mayor of the Thane Municipal Corporation Anant Tare passed away at the age of 67.
- Seven people were arrested by Special Task Force (STF) for allegedly selling and buying infants in Madhya Pradesh's Indore.
- The West Bengal government on Sunday announced a reduction of tax by ₹1 per litre on petrol and diesel effective from midnight.

- Tesla CEO Elon Musk lost \$15.2 billion in a day after Tesla's shares slid 8.6% on .
- A new BBC documentary revealed that Donald Trump offered North Korea's Kim Jong-un a ride home on Air Force One after a 2019 summit in Vietnam, AFP reported.
- Beaches in Israel have been covered in tar which is thought to have come from a ship spilling oil.
- US' top infectious disease expert Anthony Fauci said political divisiveness contributed significantly to COVID-19 death toll in the country, which has surpassed 5 lakh.
- The US' death toll from COVID-19, the highest globally, has surpassed the number of fatalities the country suffered in World War One, World War Two and the Vietnam War combined.
- Italian Prime Minister Mario Draghi has extended travel curbs between 20 regions of the country until late March while also maintaining a 10 pm curfew.
- US Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen has said that cryptocurrency Bitcoin is an "extremely inefficient way of conducting transactions".
- India has offered over ₹724 crore in Line of Credit to Mauritius to facilitate procurement of defence assets.
- Italy's ambassador to the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), an Italian military policeman and a Congolese driver have been killed in an attack on a UN convoy.
- China faces a "critical and urgent" task to overhaul Hong Kong's electoral system, Xia Baolong, Director of China's cabinet-level Hong Kong and Macau Affairs Office has said.
- The UN High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) has called for the immediate rescue of a group of Rohingya refugees who are adrift in their boat in the Andaman Sea without food or water.
- Volunteers and government rangers on Monday successfully refloated nearly 40 long-finned pilot whales after they were stranded on a remote beach in New Zealand, the Department of Conservation said.
